Paul reported: We didn't see that much but I think everyone enjoyed it. We had a Kingfisher flyby lots of Red Kites, Treecreeper, Shoveler and Gadwall and maybe a dozen Great Crested Grebes. We also saw hundreds of Cellophane Bees (plasterer bees) feeding on Ivy flowers which was quite interesting.

Several people on the Tuesday Heath walk which followed commented on having enjoyed the walk and contributed to the bird list. Highlights seem to have been the numbers of Great Crested Grebe, Gadwall and Red Kite seen as well as the Treecreeper we don't often see on the Heath.
